BY-LAW NUMBER 06 -2015

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NUMBER 57-2014 BEING A PROCEDURAL BY-LAW TO GOVERN THE PROCEEDINGS OF COUNCIL, ITS COMMITTEES AND BOARDS

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Shelburne deems it expedient to amend By-law Number 57-2014;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Shelburne enacts the following:

1. By-law 57-2014 to add under the heading of 1."Interpretation" the following definition:

“Consent agenda and consent items are items considered to be routine, housekeeping, information and non-controversial that is not seeking discussion and can be approved by one motion.”

2. By-law 57-2014 to add under the heading of 1."Interpretation" the following definition:

“Regular agenda items are considered as matter requiring individual consideration including discussion, questions and a separate motion to provide direction”

3. By-law 57-2014 to be deleted and replaced under heading 5."Council Agenda" the following wording and format:

- Call to Order
- Approval of Agenda
- Disclosure of Pecuniary Interest
- Approval of minutes from Previous Council Meeting
- Business Arising from Previous Council Minutes
- Question Period
- Delegations
- Request to lift consent agenda items for separate consideration
- Consent Agenda including Reports, By-laws, Correspondence
- Regular Agenda including Reports, Correspondence requiring specific action, By-laws and New Business
- Approval of Bills and Accounts
- Closed Session
- Matter Arising from Closed Session
- Adjournment
